For Android: **Allow installation**, Navigate to your device's **Settings**, select **Security** or **Applications** (depending on device) and check the **Unknown Sources** box.

### **Shared Housing on the Masonic Homes campus in Covina**

A new concept, "Shared Housing", is close to opening on the Masonic Homes campus in Covina.

Two of the houses formerly used as Masonic orphan's housing are being converted into "Shared Housing" rental units for "Independent Living". Each home offers 7 units, consisted of 3 studios and 4 suites.

Each house will contain four one bedroom suites and three studio units each with it's private bathroom. The common areas will include two kitchens, a dining area, laundry, living room, sitting area, patio, and an elevator.

To apply for Shared Housingyou must be 62 years of age, independent, and meet the membership requirements. You will also need to apply and be on Masonic Outreach Senior Services financial assistance for 3 months, prior to applying for Shared Housing. This will help facilitate an orderly transition to "Assisted Living," should it become needed in the future.

While the "Shared Housing" units will be separate from the other units of the Covina facility, some of those facilities will be available for use.

Occupancy by residents is expected to begin in late March or early April. Lodge Pillars and "Outreach Coordinators" of Masonic Division IX Lodges will be invited to tour the "Shared Housing" when occupancy opens.
