
### **Grand Master's Restoration Campaign**

### **Masonic History in June**



June 1867 – A President Initiated in the White House Andrew Johnson became the first (and only) U.S. president to receive a Masonic degree inside the Executive Mansion, squeezed in during his official schedule.



June 6 1876 – Imperial Council of the Shriners Organized
Thirty-two Nobles met at Mecca Temple in New York City, creating
the governing body that would evolve into Shriners International and
its famous charity hospitals.



June 11 1898 – Masonic Home of New Jersey Founded New Jersey Freemasons opened a home in Burlington for aged and infirm members—an early example of the fraternity's commitment to organized charity.



June 24 – Feast of St John the Baptist Mid-summer's "St John's Day" has been celebrated by Masons since medieval times; many early lodges installed their officers on this date, and it remains a traditional red-letter day on Masonic calendars worldwide.



**June 24 1717 – Birth of Modern Freemasonry** Four London lodges met at the Goose & Gridiron tavern and formed the first Grand Lodge, the forerunner of today's United Grand Lodge of England.



24 June 1732 – Benjamin Franklin's First Grand-Lodge Office Just a year after his initiation, Franklin was appointed Junior Warden of the Grand Lodge of Pennsylvania—his first step toward becoming its Grand Master in 1734.



**27 June 1791 – Grand Lodge of Rhode Island Constituted**Delegates from Newport and Providence lodges met in the State
House at Newport to organize the jurisdiction's independent Grand Lodge.
