

Masonic History in August

August 4, 1753: George Washington Becomes a Master Mason

On this day, Brother George Washington, a key figure in American history, completed his Masonic journey to become a Master Mason in Fredericksburg, Virginia. His active participation in the Craft, including serving as Worshipful Master, highlights the deep connection between early American leaders and Freemasonry's principles of liberty and public service.

August 9, 1863: The First Lodge in Idaho Was Chartered

Boise Lodge No. 1 received its charter on this date, becoming the first Masonic lodge in Idaho. This event underscores Freemasonry's vital role in the American westward expansion, providing community, moral guidance, and brotherly support in new territories.

August 11, 1904: Freemasons Lay the Cornerstone for the New City Hall in Savannah, Georgia

Continuing a long-standing tradition, the Masons of Savannah laid the cornerstone for their new City Hall. This public ceremony demonstrated the Craft's commitment to civic development, good governance, and the enduring principles of architecture and design within their community.

August 20th: Recognized as a National Day of Freemasonry in Brazil

This day holds special significance for Freemasons in Brazil, commemorating the establishment of the Grande Oriente do Brasil in 1822. It is a day to honor the Craft's rich history and its contributions to Brazilian society, culture, and independence.

August 22, 1820: James Monroe Attends the Cornerstone Ceremony for the District's First City Hall

Brother James Monroe, then U.S. President, attended the cornerstone ceremony for the District of Columbia's first City Hall. His presence highlighted the strong historical ties between American leadership and Freemasonry, showcasing shared values in public service and institutional development.
