

### **Masonic History in November**



November 4, 1752 – George Washington Initiated - At age 20, George Washington was initiated as an Entered Apprentice in the lodge at Fredericksburg, Virginia — later known as Fredericksburg Lodge No. 4. The date comes from the lodge's early minutes and is accepted in Masonic tradition, though independent verification is limited



October 3, 1789 – Washington's Thanksgiving Proclamation - President Washington issued the first national Thanksgiving Proclamation on October 3, 1789, designating November 26 as a "Day of Public Thanksgiving and Prayer." While sometimes misdated as November 17, the actual date is October 3. The proclamation reflects Washington's civic ideals but was not a Masonic event.



November 9, 1848 – Charter for California Lodge No. 13 - A charter or dispensation was granted for California Lodge No. 13 under the Grand Lodge of the District of Columbia, later renumbered as California Lodge No. 1. Though the exact date is debated, the lodge was active by mid-November 1848, marking the start of organized Masonry in California.



November 4, 1850 – Albert Pike Raised a Master Mason - Albert Pike was raised a Master Mason in Western Star Lodge at Little Rock, Arkansas, on or about November 4, 1850. Sources differ on the lodge number (No. 2 or No. 22), but this event is well established in Masonic tradition and marks the beginning of Pike's distinguished Masonic career.



November 15, 1848 – First Lodge Meeting in California- California Lodge No. 13 (now No. 1) held its first meeting on November 15, 1848, in the Genella Building on Montgomery Street, San Francisco. Often misdated as 1849, this meeting formally began Freemasonry's organized presence in California.
