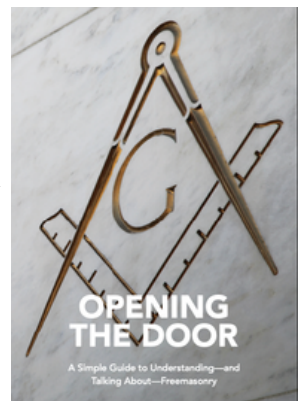
Happy Springtime Brethren!

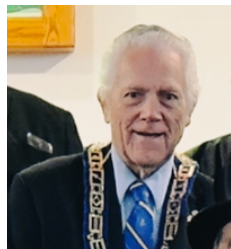
